# PSU-GRADUATE STUDIES SCHOLARSHIP 2026

## For International Students

### Scholarship Support:

#### 1. Monthly expenses as a lump sum payment:

- Master's Level: 8,500 Baht/month
- Doctoral Level: 12,000 Baht/month

#### 2. Tuition fees waiver

### Scholarship Duration:

1. Master Students
  - 2 academic years
2. Doctoral Students
  - 3 academic years for Master's degree holders
  - 4 academic years for Bachelor's degree holders

Note: Scholarship duration depends on the program's start semester and retention period, which determines the amount of funding.

### Applicant Qualifications

- Applicants must reside on campus and attend classes full-time in order to be eligible for scholarships.
- Applicants must not be recipients of any other scholarships that provide tuition and/or monthly living expenses. If later discovered, the total scholarship amount received must be reimbursed.
- Applicants must have a GPA of at least 3.00, or an equivalent of 75% or higher, and must be able to conduct full-time research until graduation.

### Terms and Conditions:

- The scholars must submit proof of English proficiency that meets the graduation requirements of the Graduate School and/or program requirements (PSU-TEP, CU-TEP, TOEFL, TOEFL-ITP, or IELTS) via the Graduate Studies Management and Information System (GSMS) by November 30, 2026.
- The scholars must submit the progress report and study results every 6 months
- The scholars must have publications in reputable international peer-reviewed journals that are recognized in international databases before graduation, as follows:
  - 👉 **Field of Science and Technology and Health Sciences:**  
2 publications for doctoral level, 1 publication for master level  
(all levels indexed by Web of Science)
  - 👉 **Field of Humanities and Social Sciences:**  
2 publications for doctoral level, 1 publication for master level  
(all levels indexed by Scopus (Q1/Q2))
- The scholars who are employed and receive a salary during the study period, or are enrolled in online programs, are not eligible for monthly expenses.
- The scholars will not be eligible to apply for Research Grant for Thesis.
